1 Gal. Red Wine
 4 bottles (Qt.) Champagne
 1 Bottle (Qt.) Vodka
 1 oz. Lime
 Ice Cubes to Chill

Non-Alcoholic Punch

2 Cans Frozen Orange Juice
 2 Cans Frozen Lemonade
 8 Cans Plain Water
 2 Cups Grenadine
 Juice of 3 Fresh Lemons
 3 Qts. (Pre-chilled) Ginger Ale
 Float orange slices on top.
 Add cherries

Hospitality Punch

3-oz. Fresh Lemon Juice
 8-oz. Cranberry Juice Cocktail
 8-oz. Blended Whiskey
 24-oz. Pre-chilled Squirt or Wink
 Mix in punch bowl. Add cake Of ice and decorate with Orange and lemon slices.

Open House Punch

1 Small can (6 oz) Frozen Orange Juice Concentrate
 2 Small Cans (Total 12 oz)- Frozen Lemonade Concentrate
 2 ¼ Qts. (72 oz) Pre-chilled 7up
 2 ¼ Cups (20 oz) Blended- Whiskey
 Mix in punch bowl, adding 7-Up last. Add drops of red food Coloring as desired (optional). Add ice cubes or lump of ice. Garnish with fresh fruit.

Our Rental Day

Our normal rental day is a 24-hour period. However... we will allow time for customer pickup and return and special consideration will be allowed for special events. The exact terms will be established at the time of the rental and these terms will appear on the rental contract.

Any merchandise kept longer than specified will be charged according to the following schedule:

1. Overdue rentals will be charged at the day rate for each additional day that the merchandise is kept.
2. Long-term rental rates shall be established prior to the beginning of the rental period.

Deposits

We will require a deposit on some of our rental items. Deposits will be refunded to the customer providing the merchandise is returned in the proper condition as indicated on the rental contract. Deposits shall be in advance and in addition to all other charges. Tent deposits are in advance and non-refundable.

Delivery & Pickup Rates

We charge for all deliveries and pickups.
All deliveries are done at our convenience.
Delivery charge is to the door ONLY.
Premium rates will be charged for indoor deliveries, weekends and "special time" deliveries.

WE CHARGE FOR WAIT TIME!

Our delivery personnel are instructed to neatly stack all items in a mutually convenient place on delivery. On pick-up all items should be stacked, tables folded, chairs bagged and ready to go. Set up and knock down service is available at reasonable additional cost if arranged well In advance.

China, silver, utensils, glassware, etc. must be returned cleaned and repacked in appropriate boxes. With the exception of linen, we are not allowed to accept soiled items for return.

Responsibility for equipment remains with the lessor from the time of delivery to time of return. Please be sure equipment is secured when not in use and protected from the weather. Check with the management of hired halls to Make sure they will take care of this for you. We do make moderate charges for missing items or breakage. However, we have found breakage to be a minimum and not really a serious problem.
